After serving as evangelism pastor for two congregations in the Midwest, starting a variety of ministries and worship services within those congregations, Bill and his family returned to Texas in 1997 and planted CrossPoint Community Church in Katy, a congregation that led the LCMS in baptisms for most of the 2000s. During that time he also worked with 100's of church planters equipping them to more effectively reach their communities.

In 2009, he started a network called FiveTwo, whose name comes from the five loaves and two fish in the feeding of the five thousand.
